Physical Development	We will develop our tripod grip when holding pencils and pens and look at forming letters correctly. During P.E and when playing in the garden we will continue to use bats, balls, skipping ropes and hoops to play games.	We will continue to develop our tripod grip and look at forming our letters correctly including using anticlockwise movements and sitting correctly on our chair and holding our paper to help us. We will show control when using equipment and prepare for our sports day activities.
Literacy	We will continue our phonics work by learning more complicated sounds and use them when reading and writing. We will be reading 'I am a Butterfly', 'The Egg' and 'Handa's Surprise'. Using these texts we will be writing information fact sheets and writing our own stories.	We will continue to look at blending sounds together to read words and segmenting them to use in our writing. We will be reading 'The Rainbow Fish', 'Surprising Sharks' and 'Commotion in the Ocean' We will be writing information facts and creating our own stories.
Mathematics	Number – Counting past 10 using a hundreds squares and identifying patterns. Counting up and down number lines and knowing which is 1 more or less.
