Does the toy require your child's personal information? Only put in the minimal amount of information or keep it general.

Are there any features such as a camera that might put a child at risk? Is the camera open to a wider community? Are the pictures that are taken to be shared?

Is there a monthly subscription to access new content with the toy? Read the terms and condition and reviews online to make sure there are no surprises!
