celebrates today is the manifestation of our Lord to the whole world, after being made known to the shepherds of Bethlehem He is revealed to the Magi who have come from the East to adore Him. The Magi, the first of the Gentiles to visit the baby, lead in

their wake all the peoples of the earth, and thus the Epiphany is an affirmation of universal salvation.


