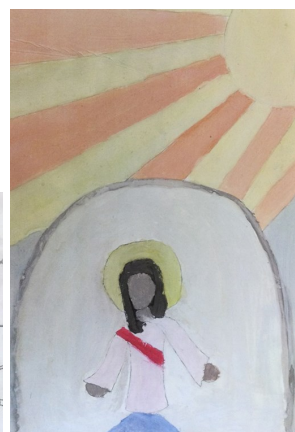
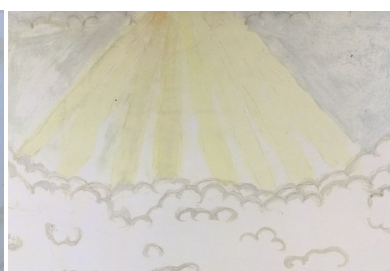

Sledges used on one of Shackleton's expeditions to Antarctica. The original sail from the James Caird boat.



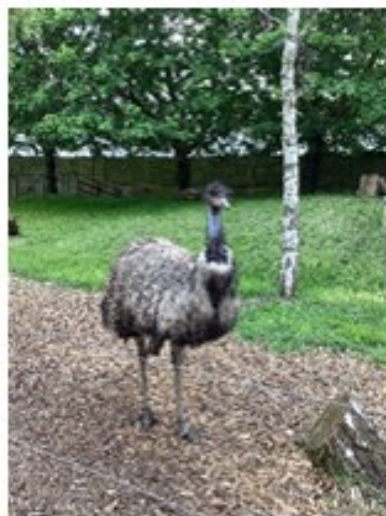

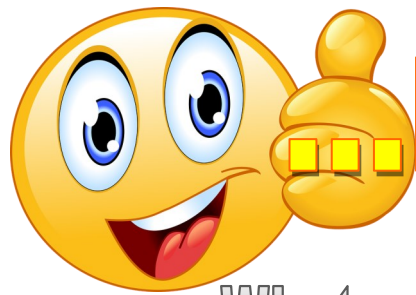

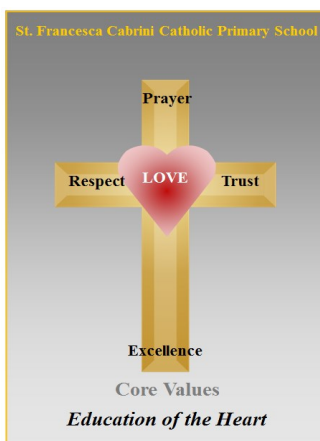
