## Happy Feast Day


Today we celebrate the Feast Day of St Francesca Cabrini. A woman who dedicated her life for the betterment of those who found themselves in a foreign land, far from home, often with no one to turn to. Along with her sisters she dedicated her 'mission' to helping migrants, initially in a new metropolis being built called New York City. Mother Cabrini and her

Missionary Sisters soon spread this 'mission' to many other places across the globe. In her life time she opened 69 different missions. Her focus always being migrants, the sick, the poor, the lonely and the needy, more often than not children of migrants. As the patroness of Immigrants her legacy today seems more poignant. We watch the growing refugee crisis throughout the world and the desperate attempt by displaced people on our own shores. Images of families jumping in to unsafe vessels to cross the English Chanel appear daily in our news coverage, these people simply hoping for a better life and a safe place to call home. We think of her work today and how her work lives on in over 17 countries throughout the world, including here in London. Pray today for those who find themselves in a similar predicament today as those migrants during her lifetime, pray they be helped to find peace and safety and a place they can call home.
